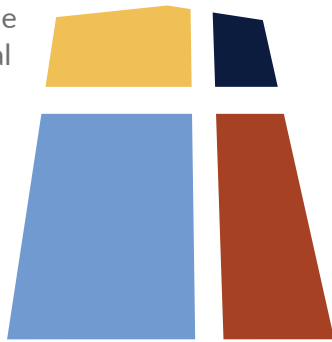


A New Season at Normandale

SUNDAYS

9:00 AM: Sanctuary Worship

Join us for traditional Lutheran worship with organ, choir, and song. Holy Communion is celebrated on the first and third Sundays of each month.

10:10 AM: Fellowship & Faith Formation Hour

Gather between services for thoughtful conversation and community. Adults meet in the Fellowship Hall. Sunday School takes place in the Education Wing.

A simpler, piano-led service in a smaller, quieter, and more accessible setting. Holy Communion is celebrated every Sunday.

Our principal Sunday service continues in the sanctuary with choir, organ, congregational song, preaching, prayer, and Holy Communion. Richly rooted in the Lutheran tradition, this service remains the heart of our shared worship life.



Fellowship & Faith Formation Hour SUNDAYS AT 10:10 AM

Between services, we gather together. In the Fellowship Hall, adults gather for thoughtful conversations on Scripture, theology, Christian life, and the questions shaping our communities and world. Pre-K through 5th grade students gather for Sunday School in the Education Wing.



Chapel Worship SUNDAYS AT 11:15 AM

We've heard from many who longed for a later worship opportunity and also those seeking a worship environment that feels smaller, quieter, and more accessible. Simpler and shorter, centered on Scripture, preaching, prayer, and weekly Holy Communion, it is led by piano and intentionally shaped as a quieter, lower-sensory worship experience.
